The goals of the trip include:

1. Continuing assessment (E coli sampling, address mapping/network gaps, water pressure characterization/troubleshooting)
2. Domestic system improvements: Pre-design activities and Implementation (top-down approach)
3. Pre-Design activities related to Irrigation System Improvements; limited implementation
4. Continued community training (plumbing, O&M, environmental data collection)
5. Update on health assessment
6. Other: Waste handling, treatment issues, etc -- ideas?
